BUDDY HUNT, COURSES & BIRDS:

Buddy Hunt - Junior Hunter test handlers may be accompanied in the field by one person to support the handler. The buddy may not handle the dog in the test, only advise the handler.

MH & SH single course without bird field with shooting on course.
JH single course without bird field. Only blank starter pistols to be used in JH test. All live shooting done by official gunners. Liberated quail used in each test.

GALLERY must remain behind the judges. **Orange MUST be worn by everyone in all tests, including JH and the gallery, per GMHT rules.**

PRIZES: Standard AKC Rosettes to all qualifying dogs and New Title ribbons.

WAIT LIST

Entries received before closing for a test level that is full will be placed on a wait list. The AKC allows for wait listed entries to be allowed into the event after closing, should space open up. Dogs will be waitlisted according to the date/time the entries are received, and should space open in that test level, the secretary will extend an offer to enter.

Junior Fun Run Friday morning

Junior handlers and dogs will have an opportunity for a fun run with bird exposure, with coaching available upon request. Fun runs will be at least 15 minutes, depending on the number of advance entries and day-of sign-ups. Entry is \$35.00 per dog in advance and \$40.00 per dog for day-of sign-ups as time permits. Preference in the running order will be given to advance entries.

HUNTING DOG STAKE Friday afternoon

Non-regular walking fun stake open to all pointing breeds.

This stake is designed to focus on dogs that have completed their JH title and working towards the SH title, or dogs that need a chance to compete and obtain fieldwork to both improve their hunting abilities and to showcase their existing talents. Each brace is at least 15 minutes, depending on the number of advance entries and day-of sign-ups. Dogs may be collared while on point and may run with a check cord. Entry is \$35.00 per dog in advance and \$40.00 per dog for day-of sign-ups as time permits. Preference in the running order will be given to advance entries.

Eligibility:

Any dog that is eligible to compete in licensed AKC pointing breed field trials or hunt tests is eligible to run in Hunting Dog Stakes. Placements will be made at the end of the day and ribbons will be awarded for places 1-4.

A dog may run, but is not eligible for placements in a stake if it:

- Has completed a Senior Hunter or Master Hunter title.
- Has placed 1st in a broke dog stake.
- Is a previous Hunting Dog of the Year winner

Other breeds, or Vizslas not owned by TBVC members, are eligible for placement at individual stakes only. Only Vizslas owned by TBVC members are eligible for cumulative placements and for the Hunting Dog of the Year. Bitches in season may not run in Hunting Dog Stake. See complete rules and information on the TBVC website under the Events drop down.

Judging:

Judging is done by the gunners. Each dog is judged based on the dog's actual performance and its potential as a worthy hunting companion.

Please sign up for both of these fun stakes via Perfdog.

The Perfdog processing fee also applies to fun stake entries.

Lunches will be available on Saturday and Sunday for \$10.00.

On Saturday evening, there will be a happy hour at 6 pm-ish, (BYO hors d'oeuvres to share and adult beverages of your choice). Dinner will be served after happy hour for \$15.00. Meal reservations and payment can be made on Perfdog, and also payment at the event.

Before Saturday dinner we will be having a TBVC General Meeting, non-members welcomed! At this time, we will have a Remembrance Ceremony for Marcia Schlesinger, with her brother, Maury attending. Bring your best Marcia stories, as we raise our toasts to our friend.

Judges' and spouses' dinner will be provided on Friday night, location TBD; reservations at a local restaurant or at the grounds.

Charging for an electric vehicle will be by reservation only for \$40.00 per day/night. Charging an electric cart \$30.00 per weekend. No charge for GMHT members.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship and Civility 2025

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs. These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.

- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
 - Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
 - The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
 - The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
 - The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
 - The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
 - Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
 - Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
 - Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
